<b>Language:</b>		
Are there grammatical errors?		
Are there language or typological errors?		
Are there poorly constructed sentences?		
Are there unnecessary abbreviations?		
Are the abbreviations used intuitive?		
Is the information correctly separated into individual paragraphs?		
<b>Title</b>		
Does the title clearly describe the findings of the manuscript?		
<b>Abstract</b>		
Is the rationale for performing the study clear?		
Is the objective of the manuscript clear?		
Are experimental details given in enough detail?		
Does the abstract reflect the main findings of the manuscript?		
Does the abstract provide a meaningful conclusion?		
<b>Introduction:</b>		
Is the rationale for doing the study clearly described in the context of the literature?		
Are the study objectives/hypotheses clearly described?		
Are methodological details provided with enough detail?		
<b>Methods:</b>		
Is sufficient detail provided to allow others to replicate the study?		
Are the methods and statistics appropriate for addressing the aims of the study?		
Are the equipment, materials, and procedures adequately described?		
<b>Results:</b>		
Are the results presented clearly?		
Are the results presented concisely?		
Are the results presented well organized and with enough detail?		
<b>Discussion and Conclusions:</b>		
Does the discussion include misplaced introductory information?		
Does the discussion include an unnecessary repetition of the results?		
Does the discussion provide further explanations of the results?		
Does the discussion place the results in a more global context?		
Are the conclusions provided meaningful?		
Are the conclusions provided a true summary of the paper's findings?
